



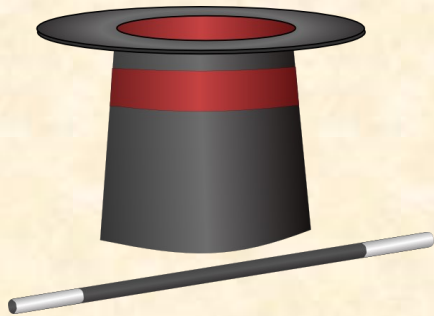

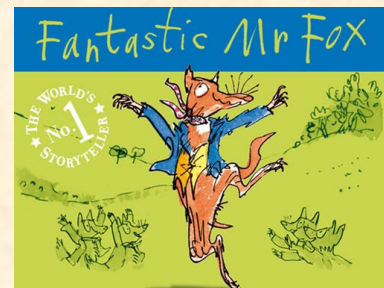
April 6, 2017 4pm
