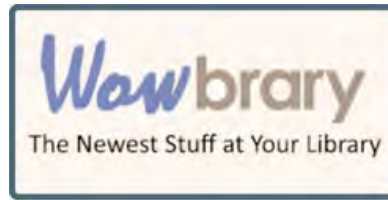
We are a member of the NC Cardinal Consortium, which gives you an additional 7 million items to borrow and share. Our catalog is available online at burke.nccardinal.org
